SUBJ: CHANGE IN CLASSIFICATION OF ACCREDITATION/REACCREDITATION MESSAGES

REFS: A. DOD 5105.21-M-1, DATED 3 AUGUST 1998 (U//FOUO)

B. ICS 705-2, DATED 17 SEPTEMBER 2010 (U)

1. (U) EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, DIA WILL NO LONGER INCLUDE THE SCI COMPARTMENTS THAT A SCIF IS AUTHORIZED TO PROCESS IN SCIF ACCREDITATION AND REACCREDITATION MESSAGES TO AFFORD STAKEHOLDERS GREATER FLEXIBILITY WHEN CORRESPONDING BETWEEN COMMUNICATIONS MEDIUMS. THEREFORE, ACCREDITATIONS AND REACCREDITATION MESSAGES WILL BE CLASSIFIED AS "UNCLASSIFIED//FOUO" IN ACCORDANCE WITH CLASSIFICATION GUIDANCE CONTAINED IN REFERENCE (B). ALL FIXED FACILITY CHECKLISTS (FFC) WILL CONTINUE TO BE CLASSIFIED AT A MINIMUM CLASSIFICATION OF CONFIDENTIAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH REFERENCE (A).

2. (U) THIS ACTION CONFORMS WITH REFERENCE (B) WHICH DOES NOT REQUIRE THE LETTER OF ACCREDITATION TO STATE WHICH ACTUAL COMPARTMENTS ARE INCLUDED IN THE ACCREDITATION. PRIOR ACCREDITATION AND REACCREDITATION MESSAGES WHICH LIST THE SCI COMPARTMENTS AUTHORIZED TO BE PROCESSED IN THE SCIF WILL CONTINUE TO BE CLASSIFIED AT A MINIMUM OF CONFIDENTIAL.

3. (U) REFER TO THE POLICY CHANGES IN THE ABOVE REFERENCES REGARDING THE COMPILATION OF SCIF INFORMATION. AS STATED IN CHAPTER 5, PARAGRAPH G.3 OF REFERENCE (A), A MINIMUM CLASSIFICATION OF CONFIDENTIAL IS NO LONGER REQUIRED. LIKewise, PARAGRAPH D.1.A OF REFERENCE (B) REQUIRES ONLY THE SCIF ID AND SCIF TYPE ALONG WITH SUBPARAGRAPH INFORMATION TO BE ANNOTATED AND NOT THE SCI ACCESS LEVELS.
